About Our May 16th Meeting: Roadway Repairs

The Board has identified and prioritized areas of the community roadways that require attention. A comprehensive list is currently being finalized.

We have agreed to move forward with pothole repairs across all roads, with the goal of completing this work prior to the May 16 General Membership Meeting.

In addition: We are also obtaining pricing for larger roadway repair projects that were discussed and approved for further review. Further updates will be shared as scheduling and contractor details are confirmed.

Your Attendance Is Strongly Urged!

A recent budget review highlighted that approximately \$8,000 from last year's roadway repair budget remains unspent.

With this carryover, combined with newly collected dues, the Association is in a strong financial position to complete a substantial amount of road work during the upcoming season.
